Course annotation
The "geological turn" in philosophy. The Anthropocene as a geological process and as an event of self-awareness in the humanities and social sciences. Definitions, diagnoses and narratives of the epoch. Naturalistic, post-naturalistic, eco-Marxist, eco-phenomenological narratives.
Genesis of the Anthropocene. The mathematization and reduction of nature to a resource in New Age modernity. The end of nature as a feature of late modernity. The relationship between the Anthropocene and late modernity. Attempts to go beyond modernity - B. Latour, D. Haraway.
The Anthropocene and the critique of anthropocentrism. The formation of anthropocentrism in the Western tradition of thought and the main aspects of the critique of anthropocentrism: posthumanism, G. Agamben (anthropological machine), J. Derrida (logocentrism as anthropocentrism).
The Anthropocene as a problem of imagination. The emergence of the global imagination and paradigm shifts: B. Latour's "Globe vs. Gaya", D. Chakrabarty's "Globe vs. The Planetary".
The Anthropocene and the question of human responsibility. The expansion of responsibility and the question of its limits.
The problem of conceptualizing the relationship between the individual and the milieu/environment. J. von Uexküll, G. Canguilhem, G. Simondon, M. Merleau-Ponty, D. Haraway, B. Latour.
