## Course annotation

Conceptions and programmes of social scientific explanation. Positivism and antipositvism, analytics and narratvism, behaviorism and culturalism, individualism and holism, realism and constructivism, contextualism and unversalism, actionism and structuralism, consensualim and conflictology, reliativism and anti-reliativism as methodological dilemmas in social science. Maximalist and minimalist strategies in conceptualisation. Typologies and taxonomies. The concept of ideal type. Description in social science. The idea of measurement, concepts of its validity and reliability. The criteria of quality of descriptions and causal hypotheses. Statistical and deterministic ideas of causation. The experimental, statistical, comparative and case study methods in control of causal hypotheses, their comparative advantages and weaknesses. Qualitative and quantitative strategies of social research. Rational choice approach as methodology of social explanation, its difficulties and varieties. The issue of the methodological autonomy of historical studies.
